#### **A** WARNING

- 1. Do not leave child unattended with product while in use.
- 2. Avoid scratching goggles lens.
- 3. Do NOT dive into the water.
- 4. CAUTION: Keep out of baby's reach.
- 5. WARNING: Aquatic toy. Use only under supervision.
- 6. The product is not a life-saving device.
- 7. Only to be used in water in which the child is under adult supervision.
- 8. The product must be assembled/disassembled by an adult.
- 9. WARNING: Only for domestic use.
- 10. Keep the assembly and installation instructions for further reference.
- 11. WARNING: Never pull eye cups away from face, as they may spring back and cause eye damage.
- 12. Goggles are for children only.
- 13. Keep away from fire.





## **A** INSTRUCTIONS OF USE

Before assembling your product, please take a few minutes to check the contents and become familiar with all the parts.

## Wearing Goggles:

- 1. Remove protective film from goggles lens before use.
- 2. Adjust goggle head strap and bridge strap to a proper and comfortable position.
  - The head strap is used to hold the goggles in place.
  - Tighter is not necessarily better, as this may cause discomfort and marking around the eyes.
  - Correct adjustment can be obtained by tensioning the band until a comfortable fit is achieved.
  - Correct adjustment of the bridge strap is essential for both comfort and a watertight seal.
- 3. To avoid water intake, slide the lenses closer together or further apart one notch at a time until the correct fit is obtained.
- 4. To clear water or to adjust goggles, take a firm grip on the eye cup and tilt the lower edge of the eye cup slightly away from the face.
- 5. To remove goggles, put thumbs under head strap at side of head. Slide thumbs to back of head, and lift elastic from back to front of head.
- 6. It is recommended that teachers, coaches, or mature swimmers demonstrate this method to young children.



## The 3D Goggles must be worn to see the 3D effect inside the pool.

#### Care Instructions:

- 1. Rinse goggles with cold tap water before storage.
- 2. Air-dry goggles, and store in dry place. Do not store in direct sunlight.
